



MEMBER HIGHLIGHT

When **Dayalan Rajaratnam CC'17** and **Kayla Maloney CC'17** decided to join the Young Leaders Council (YLC) in 2024, they both knew they wanted to give back to the institution that helped them get to where they are today. Both were eager to reflect on their unique journeys that led them to Columbia and ultimately inspired their commitment to supporting future generations of students.

For Dayalan, the connection to the University started early. As a high school student, he participated in one of Columbia's pre-college programs. He became eager to experience all the opportunities that come with being a college student in the heart of New York City and to take part in the school's vibrant community and student groups.

Kayla's introduction to Columbia took a different route. Originally from Boston, Massachusetts, she arrived as a recruited athlete for the University's Division I softball team. She recalls how the energy of New York City and the breadth of academic programs left a lasting impression, offering a completely new experience beyond her New England roots.

Both Dayalan and Kayla thrived at Columbia, **fully engaging in the institution's diverse offerings**. Dayalan found his niche in entrepreneurial initiatives, such as the Lion Credit Union, and pioneered roles in student-run investment groups like Lion Fund. Kayla balanced her passion for science with her commitment to athletics, building friendships and experiences that would extend far beyond her time on campus.

Their paths finally converged during their junior year when they met through a campus Christian ministry. A planned winter formal turned into an impromptu night exploring the city, which solidified their bond. "We had a spontaneous Christmas adventure in New York," Dayalan recalls, smiling at the memory. "It felt like a scene from a Hallmark movie." Five years later, the two were married. Now residing in Boston, Kayla works as a pediatric nurse practitioner and Dayalan works at a hedge fund.

For Kayla, who attended with the help of scholarships, giving back is especially meaningful. She hopes their contributions, both financial and through mentorship, can open doors for future students. **"It's about creating opportunities and ensuring that financial barriers don't stand in the way of someone's education,"** she adds.

Dayalan and Kayla are looking for creative ways to give back and strengthen the link between alumni and current students. As members of the YLC, they are excited about connecting with fellow alumni leaders who share their passion for philanthropy and providing students the opportunity to experience all that Columbia has to offer.
